

2021 Year in Review

President's Report - Ron Heesen

Looking back on another year living through a global pandemic, there is one thing that was made clear: our donors responded with generosity. And, local charities rose to the unprecedented challenge of responding to the increased demand for programs and services for members of our community.

Highlights

Our financial reports for the period August 1, 2020 to July 31, 2021 reveal


- o More than 250 donors contributed over \$717k in 2021, up from \$268k in 2020
- o Investment income for 2021 was over \$1.1m, up from \$0.34m in 2020
- Our assets under management have reached \$5.3m, up from \$3.6m in 2020
- Currently 50 charities, service clubs, families, and organizations have established endowment funds with PDCF, up from 47 in 2020
- PDCF grants to local charities in 2021 totaled \$271k, up from \$217.5k in 2020
- In addition, through the Community Foundations of Canada, PDCF administered two rounds of *Emergency Community Support Fund* (ECSF) totaling \$264k which was made available to organizations in Lanark County to support vulnerable populations.
- o From 2003-2021, PDCF grants benefiting children, youth, seniors, and families totaled \$1.5m (not including the Emergency Community Support Fund)


We put a renewed emphasis on communication with current and potential donors by revamping and updating our website, producing and distributing brochures, issuing a quarterly newsletter, and phoning a number of our donors to convey our appreciation.

We have done the ground work to undertake Vital Signs in 2022, with a particular focus on the impact of the pandemic on our community.

In anticipation of our 20th anniversary in 2022, we started preparing special activities with the theme *community celebrating community*.

We would not have had these results without our generous donors, strong board members, and the efforts of community members who contribute to our committees.

Plus, the PDCF gave a **Special \$5k Grant to fund a Youth Mental Health First Aid Course** in June 2021 bringing the total grants awarded through the PDCF's unrestricted fund in 2021 to \$71,058.

The PDCF recognized that far too many youth in our community were [and are] experiencing mental health problems as a result of COVID-19. In response, we gave a special \$5,000 grant to the Youth Action Kommittee (YAK), Perth to offer a mental health first aid course to 11 youth workers at the Lanark Highlands Youth Centre and YAK Youth Services, and four youth in the summer of 2021. Participants commented on how much they learned and how much more confident they are talking to youth about mental health concerns.





Community Foundations of Canada in cooperation with the **Government of Canada** announced the **Investment Readiness Program** to provide non-repayable funds to organizations preparing to successfully participate in the social finance market. PDCF was one of regional partners delivering the program for Lanark, Renfrew and the United Counties of Leeds and Grenville on behalf of the Community Foundations of Canada.

4. Grants:

The Foundation incurs expenses on an annual basis in the form of grants to qualified donees. The funds received for granting purposes are derived from two sources. The first source is through investment income earned on the Foundations' endowed capital. The second source is through gifts received from donors whereby the donor has designated that the amount of the gift, less an agreed upon administrative fee, is to be directed immediately to an agency or agencies specified by the donor (provided that the agency is a "qualified donee"). The latter are referred to as "flow through" grants. Flow through grants for 2021 totalled \$14,935 (2020 - \$14,963).
